

Analisa Teachworth (1987). Detroit, Michigan

Based between New York City and Berlin, Analisa Teachworth is a multidisciplinary artist whose practice includes painting, sculpture, installation, video, and sound. Teachworth ties personal experience to allegory, constructing a unique lexicon. Through an investigation of materials and form, her work examines relationships between experience and place, noting the artist's upbringing in a desolate landscape of post-industrial Detroit and her Caribbean Puerto Rican ancestry. Illustrating subjects such as addressing the materiality and mythology of being vs. displacement, dwelling, and regeneration are the foundations upon which her works are crafted.

Teachworth's work interchanges through multifarious mediums and historical references to remodel our relationship to the natural vs. artificial, highlighting the agency of ethics used within contemporary technologies. Through disciplined exchanges, research, and writing, her practice expands collective awareness, contextualizing intersections of relationality between the self and other. Her storytelling methods reveal how our systems function as reality machines that define our intellectual, emotional, and physical economies, extending beyond the inner outward onto the social fabric, with an impulse to reflect a history of femininity and post-colonial edict as reconsidered dialogue. Teachworth's visions are forms of expression that seek to reclaim and reconstruct her own experiences and the narrative of our collective history.
